- Verification of Tribal enrollment in a USET Tribal Nation (copy of ID card or verification letter from Tribal Clerk)
- Incoming Freshman or First Year Grad Student**
 - A copy of your high school or college transcript
 - Letter of acceptance from college
 - College MUST be regionally accredited through one of the following:

 - Undergrad – 250 word minimum
