USET SPF Action Alert: Push for Inclusion of Tribal Provisions in the ESEA Discussions March 13, 2015

The staff of the Senate Committee on Health, Education, Labor and Pensions (HELP) is meeting over the next few days, including through the weekend, to negotiate language for the reauthorization of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). USET has been working with the National Indian Education Association (NIEA) and others to ensure that critical Tribal issues are raised in those negotiations.

Linked here is a <u>position paper</u>, which has received wide support (including that of USET's Education Committee), that identifies key Tribal issues for this weekend's ESEA negotiations. Also attached is a <u>letter</u>, with similar language, encouraging the Senate HELP Committee to address these issues.
