



USET Resolution No. 2011:036

**UNITED SOUTH AND EASTERN TRIBES, INC. HOUSING COMMITTEE
FISCAL YEAR 2012 FUNDING PRIORITIES**

- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-six (26) federally recognized Tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** adequate funding for Tribal housing programs is essential to the health, social and economic well-being of Tribal communities; and
- WHEREAS,** the USET Housing Committee has identified the following Fiscal Year 2012 funding priorities in support of Tribal housing Programs:
- Indian Housing Block Grant
 - Indian Community Development Block Grant
 - Title VI Loan Guarantee Program
 - Section 184 Indian Home Loan Guarantee Program
 - Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act Training & Technical Assistance; and
- WHEREAS,** the United States has a special trust responsibility to Indian Tribes that is confirmed through various treaties and executive orders; and
- WHEREAS,** this special relationship must be considered when analyzing budget priorities in adherence to the President's sound fiscal responsibility and deficit reduction efforts; and
- WHEREAS,** a proposed reduction to Fiscal Year 2008 levels, with inflation considered, would equate to a drastic reduction to already severely underfunded Indian Programs; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors calls for the exemption of all Indian Programs from any mandatory budget reduction imposed for Fiscal Year 2012 and beyond; and, be it further
- RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors respectfully requests the United States Congress to support the identified funding priorities for Tribal Housing Programs.
