The National Indian Child Welfare Association is pleased to announce that we are hosting an informational webinar on the newly announced Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA) regulations on **Thursday, June 23, 2016, at 12:30 p.m. Pacific/3:30 p.m. Eastern.**

On June 8, 2016, the Bureau of Indian Affairs released the first legally-binding federal guidance on how to implement ICWA. The [regulations](#) will go into effect 180 days from the date of their release, providing time for state agencies, private agencies, and state courts to prepare for their implementation.

NICWA understands there is considerable interest in the regulations and wants to provide you with the most up-to-date information and analysis possible.

Our webinar will cover:

- Background on how the regulations were developed
- Discussion of key requirements of the new regulations (this will include some discussion of implementation issues)
- How these new requirements differ from the guidelines of the past
- What tribes and agencies can do to prepare for when the regulations go into effect, six months from now
