

The U.S. GAO released its high risk report on Feb. 15.

Within the report, GAO identified federal management of programs that serve tribes and their members as a new high risk area.

Every two years, GAO will update the report to identify and report on federal actions to improve its management of these programs.

Also on Feb. 15, the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform's Subcommittee on the Interior, Energy, and Environment held a hearing on GAO's inclusion of federal management of Indian programs on the high risk list.
