

TO: ENDORSE CONTINUATION OF BENNETT AS COMMISSIONER

UNITED SOUTHEASTERN TRIBES

RESOLUTION NO. USET-2-68

WHEREAS: The United Southeastern Tribes of Indians, the Cherokee, Choctaw, Miccosukee and Seminole, have adopted a Constitution and Bylaws which was approved by duly elected representatives of the Tribes on November 14, 1968, and

WHEREAS: The purpose of the United Southeastern Tribes of Indians is to promote the well-being of the members of their tribes, and

WHEREAS: Commissioner Bennett, being of Indian heritage, has demonstrated a keen understanding of how to achieve progress in the Indian community and has incorporated many new concepts and new approaches to development of human resources within the Indian community, and

WHEREAS: It is the opinion of this group that the present Commissioner of Indian Affairs has represented Indian interests well and his policies and administration have done a great deal in making lasting progress toward including Indians in the mainstream of American life.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That this organization endorses the continuation of Robert L. Bennett as Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

DONE THIS 15th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1968, at a regular meeting of the duly appointed representatives of the United Southeastern Tribes convened at Atlanta, Georgia, a quorum being present, by unanimous vote.
