RESOLUTION NO. USET 111-69

The United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., consisting of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians of North Carolina, the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians of Mississippi, and the Seminole and Miccosukee Tribes of Florida duly assembled in Council in Atlanta, Georgia, make the following resolution:

Whereas, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., are not receiving an adequate share of benefits from the Indian Health Service Area Office, and

Whereas, the Indian Health Service Area Office presently serving this area is located in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, which is too far from the tribes concerned, and

Whereas, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., have their headquarters in Atlanta, Georgia, which is the most centrally located city for the four tribes, and

Whereas, Atlanta, Georgia, is the center of many Federal Area Offices, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. deem it necessary that the Indian Health Service establish an Area Office in Atlanta, Georgia, to serve the health needs of the Indian people of the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc.
