RESOLUTION NO. USET 16-69

Whereas, the members of the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., consisting of the Seminoles and Miccosukees of Florida, the Choctaws of Mississippi, and the Cherokees of North Carolina have not been represented on the National Council on Indian Opportunity, and

Whereas, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., share common problems and aspirations with all Indian tribes, but at the same time have needs unique to the southeastern area of the United States, and


Whereas, now the four tribes are legally organized into the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., forming an entity representing the majority of the Indians in the Southeast.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman or a member of the Board of the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., be selected as an official member of the National Council on Indian Opportunity.
