RESOLUTION NO. USET 24-69

Whereas, the Miccosukee Tribe of Florida is living in the Flood Control District in the Southern part of the State, and

Whereas, the homes and businesses on the Miccosukee Reservation are being flooded out because of the raising of flood gates that are located in the Reservation area; and,

Whereas, this is causing extensive damage to homes and businesses as well as creating a major health hazard.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. consisting of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in North Carolina, the Choctaws of Mississippi and the Miccosukee and Seminole Tribes of Florida, support the efforts of the Miccosukee Tribe to have the flooding stopped immediately.
