RESOLUTION NO. USET 26-69

Whereas, the Secretary of the Interior has expressed an interest in involving Indians in the decision making process of the Department of the Interior and its subordinate divisions in those actions affecting Indians.

Whereas, the United Southeastern Tribe understands that the establishment of a Department of the Interior Advisory Committee on Indian Affairs is under consideration.

Whereas, the United Southeastern Tribe represents the Seminoles and the Miccosukees of Florida, the Choctaws of Mississippi and the Cherokees of North Carolina.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the United Southeastern Tribe approves of such an advisory committee and be it further resolved that Joe Dan Osceola is hereby nominated as a candidate for appointment to said board by Secretary Hickel to represent the four Southeastern Tribes.
