Whereas, there is a great need for a permanent director of the
Division of Indian Health, and

Whereas, it should be someone familiar with the health needs of
the United Southeastern Tribes,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the United Southeastern Tribes,
Inc., consisting of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in North
Carolina, the Choctaws of Mississippi, and the Miccosukee and Sem-
inole Tribes of Florida, request from the President of the United
States that Dr. Emery Johnson be appointed as permanent director
of the Division of Indian Health, U.S. Public Health Service,
because of his ability, knowledge and understanding of the needs
of the United Southeastern Tribes.
