WHEREAS, USET resolution number 20-69, dated August 13, 1969, endorsed the efforts of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians to secure immediate funding for the construction of a new high school facility, and

WHEREAS, this need is still present, and


WHEREAS, delegates to the quarterly USET meeting held in Cherokee, North Carolina, were assured that high priority would be given this concern, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., consisting of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians, and the Miccosukee and Seminole Tribes of Florida, at a regular meeting and with a quorum present, do hereby reaffirm their support of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in their effort to secure funds to construct a new high school.
