RESOLUTION NO. USET 11-14-70

WHEREAS, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. are interested in the welfare and desperate needs of other Indian people in the eastern and southern United States, and

WHEREAS, the most fundamental need of these people is access to an organization which can assist in orientation and discovery of resources to meet identifiable needs, and

WHEREAS, the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. has proved itself capable in these areas for the four member Tribes, and

WHEREAS, current funds are marginal to support the activities of the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc.; now therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. submit the attached proposal to the Office of Economic Opportunity for funding a program instrumental in assisting these Indian people toward self-development and independence; be it further

RESOLVED that while the proposal is being finalized with the Office of Economic Opportunity, Mr. Clave St. Arnaud is hereby designated as our representative and shall be responsible for the completion of the grant package for the approval of the Board of Directors of the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., prior to the submission of the proposal to the Office of Economic Opportunity.
