WHEREAS: the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., a non-profit corporation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws adopted May 27, 1969, is charged with the responsibility of assisting the Indians of the Southeastern United States in the improvement of their social and economic conditions and for other non-profit purposes; and

WHEREAS: Southeastern Indian Antiquities Survey is a non-profit, Tennessee General Welfare Corporation promoting Southeastern archaeology and working cooperatively with Southeastern Indians, and


WHEREAS: the United Southeastern Tribes is an inter-tribal organization consisting of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians of North Carolina; the Seminole Tribe of Florida, the Miccosukee Tribe of Florida; and the Choctaw Tribe of Mississippi, working together in a united effort for the welfare of their Indian people, and


WHEREAS: the Southeastern Indian Antiquities Survey has worked in harmony with the United Southeastern Tribes toward their common goal during the past three years.
