


Resolution No. USET-72-15

- WHEREAS: the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., a non-profit corporation by authority of the constitution and By-Laws adopted May 27, 1969, is charged with the responsibility of assisting the Indians of the Southeastern United States in the improvement of their social and economic conditions and for non-profit purposes, and
- WHEREAS: the United Southeastern Tribes' do not have a good working relationship with the Program Officer, Indian Health Service at the USET level, and
- WHEREAS: their efforts to resolve the difficulties existing between the United Southeastern Tribes and the Program Officer of Indian Health Service have been to no avail, and
- WHEREAS: the Program Officer of Indian Health Service having indicated through his comments and actions an unwillingness to resolve these difficulties.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the USET Board of Directors recommends to the Assistant Surgeon General, Director, Indian Health Service to strongly consider obtaining a new Program Officer who will work with all the Tribal Chairman in the USET organization.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of USET recommend that an effort be made to place the Program Officer in a position unrelated to the activities of the USET organization.
