



RE: Repealing of House Concurrent Resolution No. 108

BE IT RESOLVED, United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., Board of Directors supports the National Tribal Chairmen's Association Resolution BD-5/73-No. 23 requesting the 93rd Congress to repeal House Concurrent Resolution 108, 83rd Congress, 1st Session, which declared the sense of Congress to "free" certain Indian tribes and individuals from Federal supervision and control and to abolish Bureau of Indian Affairs offices serving those tribes.
