WHEREAS, the Coushatta Tribe of Louisiana does not have allocations of funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and


WHEREAS, there are not sufficient program services presently being provided to the Coushatta Tribe of Louisiana, and

WHEREAS, the Coushatta Tribe of Louisiana are in need of support in the development of the tribe for the benefit of its people.


