RE: BICENTENNIAL CELEBRATION SITE FOR SENECA NATION.


WHEREAS, The Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, the Seminole Tribe of Florida and the Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana have applied for and received designation as bicentennial sites; and


WHEREAS, the Seneca Nation of Indians of New York are applying and accompanying designation as a bicentennial site in the bicentennial celebration of 1976 to establish a Seneca Nation museum to benefit the Seneca Nation in the future; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., wholeheartedly supports the Seneca Nation of Indians of New York in efforts to obtain a designation as a bicentennial site and help establish a Seneca Nation Museum.
