RE: PROPOSAL FOR A BASIC MANAGEMENT TRAINING PROGRAM FOR UNITED SOUTHEASTERN TRIBES (TRIBAL LEADERS - TRIBAL EMPLOYEES).

WHEREAS, there is an increase in the size and complexity within the Tribal health organizations; and


WHEREAS, there is an increasing demand for more effective and efficient administration within Tribal health delivery operations; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal health care delivery systems, through increased local decision making opportunities, are and will be tasked with the responsibility of developing, organizing, and/or restructuring methods of delivery and coordination of health services; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that USET, Inc. Board of Directors support the proposal for a Basic Management Training Program for USET's Tribal Leaders and Tribal Employees to facilitate the process by which individual Tribes may become totally autonomous and administratively sound.
