WHEREAS, the United Southeastern Tribes have been a leader and in the forefront in health program development and management; and


WHEREAS, there is an ever increasing need for knowledge of Tribal health management capabilities and capacities; and

WHEREAS, the United Southeastern Tribes are managing a majority of their health care programs directly or indirectly; and


