TRIBAL DEVELOPMENT PROPOSAL

RESOLUTION 77-3

WHEREAS, the Southeast Regional Health Board has discussed the position open by I.H.S. on Tribal Employee Development; and

WHEREAS, the training program proposed, would establish thirty (30) competitive training positions per year for the next eight (8) years; and

WHEREAS, the U.S.E.T. area would only be allowed, at a maximum, one (1) position per year; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for more training at the local level at each Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Southeast Regional Health Board feels it will be more beneficial for these funds to be distributed to the U.S.E.T. Tribes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Southeast Regional Health Board recommends that the U.S.E.T. Board of Directors direct Mr. James Meredith, U.S.E.T. Program Director, not to support this Proposal.
