Resolution No. 77-4

HUD 701

WHEREAS, Section 701 (a) of the Housing Act of 1954, as amended by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, provides funds comprehensive planning of Indian Tribal bodies; and

WHEREAS, these funds have only been available to the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. tribes for the past four years; and

WHEREAS, funds for comprehensive planning through the 701 program have been available to other governmental entities since 1954; and


WHEREAS, these planning monies have been utilized to the greatest extent by the tribes enhancing its overall social and economic growth on the reservations; and


WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has decreased the funding level of the 701 program overall; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., in a full Board of Directors meeting held at Hollywood, Florida, on February 15-16, 1977, at which a quorum was present, request that the Department of Housing and Urban Development maintain the funding level of the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. HUD 701 program so that it may continue support of the self-determination efforts of the member tribes.
