EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., has sponsored a CETA Off-Reservation Program in the states of Kentucky, South Carolina, Washington, D.C., and West Virginia under Title III of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of April, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the program has been of great benefit to the Indian people throughout the areas served by the program, as well as United Southeastern Tribes, inc. member tribes in the area of Technical Assistance; and


WHEREAS, that the Indian people in the states presently served has expressed a desire to continue under the prime sponsorship of United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. rather than be served by their respective State Manpower Office; and


WHEREAS, United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., desires to continue the CETA Program through funding under the 1977 Fiscal Year; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of United Southeastern Tribes, Inc. in a full Board of Directors meeting held at Hollywood, Florida on February 15-16, 1977, at which a quorum was present, endorses the United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., to develop a proposal to present to the Department of Labor to continue the program in Fiscal Year 1978.
