




OPERATIONAL FUNDING FOR USET, INC. BY B.I.A.

- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., declares the need for continued operation of the USET, Inc., offices, and
- WHEREAS, USET, Inc., is a vehicle by which the overall goal of the member tribes is expressed, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Eastern Area Office and the Indian Health Service Program Office both benefit from the existence of United Southeastern Tribes, Inc., through its unifying efforts on the part of Indians in the east, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has in the past supported the operations of USET through contracts for services; now
- THEREFORE be it resolved that the Full Board of Directors in its meeting held at Hilton Head, South Carolina on May 31 through June 2, 1978, do strongly urge the Eastern Area Office of the B.I.A. to support through funding or other means the efforts on the part of USET, Inc. to reorganize its operations to be a more effective voice for its membership.
