Resolution No. 78-10


- WHEREAS: the interest of PL 94-437 was to develop the needed Health Manpower for tribal and Indian Health Service systems, and
- WHEREAS: Title I, Section 102 speaks to the development of Health Manpower recruitment programs with the priority being tribal programs, and
- WHEREAS: the process of selection for FY '79 programs was unclear to the member tribes of the United South and Eastern Tribes and those programs selected do not follow the priority of tribal programs first, and
- WHEREAS: a number of the member tribes of the United South and Eastern Tribes submitted proposals and were not funded completely, leaving the eastern tribes out of the manpower development program, and
- WHEREAS: the National Indian Health Board has recommended to Dr. Emery Johnson that the monies be divided into twelve areas of approximately \$75,000 each,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the United South and Eastern Tribes supports the position of the National Indian Health Board and urges Dr. Johnson to follow there recommendation.
