WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an inter-tribal council representing eight federally recognized American Indian Tribes in the South and Eastern United States, and


WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes have found that in order to have an impact on the legal and regulatory processes of the federal government personal testimony is necessary,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the United South and Eastern Tribes supports the testimony of the Choctaw Tribe and its representatives before congressional hearing and delegation, and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors supports the testimony of the Choctaw Tribe as it will benefit all of the Indian people east of the Mississippi.
