WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an inter-tribal council representing ten federally recognized American Indian Tribes in the Eastern United States, and


WHEREAS, the Penobscot Tribe of Maine has presented the proper credentials to the Board of Directors to satisfy membership requirements, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Penobscot Tribe of Maine is accepted for membership to USET and is accorded all the rights and privileges of membership.
