WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an inter-tribal council representing ten federally recognized American Indian tribes in the Eastern United States, and


WHEREAS, the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Main, Indian Township, has presented the proper credentials for membership in USET, and

WHEREAS, the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Maine, Indian Township, has presented to the Board of Directors, a tribal council resolution requesting membership; now


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Maine, Indian Township, is accepted for membership to United South and Eastern Tribes and is accorded all the rights and privileges of membership.
