WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an inter-tribal council representing ten federally recognized American Indian Tribes in the Eastern United States, and

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes Board of Directors feels that there should be more Indian input into the review and approval mechanisms for P.L. 94-437 grant application; and

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes Board of Directors feels that there should be more Indian readers on the P.L. 94-437 grant and contract application; and


WHEREAS, it is essential that there be objective review and comment from an independent Indian viewpoint; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors support independent Indian health professionals to act as readers who will review and score the tribal P.L. 94-437 proposals;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be forwarded to Dr. Emery Johnson, director of Indian Health Service, for action.
