Resolution No. 79-27

WHEREAS, The United South and Eastern Tribes is an intertribal council representing ten federally recognized tribes in the Eastern United States, and

WHEREAS, In the recent past, the directors of the Eastern Area offices of the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Indian Health Service have been meeting discussing common concerns and issues, and

WHEREAS, By meeting together, the long-range effect will be a better utilization of the limited resources available to the tribes, and

WHEREAS, The Administrative Operations Committee (AOC) has been given the responsibility and authority to carry out the wishes of the Board of Directors, now


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the AOC will continue in its efforts to bring together the leadership of those agencies who provide services and resources to the member tribes, and now

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the AOC will develop a Plan of Action to continue their efforts over the next year and will facilitate those efforts.
