Resolution No. 79-29

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes (USET) Board of Directors has directed USET, Inc., and the Administrative Operations Committee to work with the Eastern Area Office Bureau of Indian Affairs and their management improvement program, and

WHEREAS, the final draft of the report has been presented to the Board of Directors at their semi-annual Board of Directors meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reviewed the final draft and made recommendations for change and approved the report in final draft form, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the USET Board of Directors support the recommendations and implementation plan outlined in the report, and now

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Assistant Secretary for Indian Affairs, the Commissioner of the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Eastern Area Director meet with the elected leadership of the member tribes of USET to discuss the implementation of the recommendations of this report, and now

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, because of the urgency of need for the implementation of the recommendations outlined in the report and the Assistant Secretary's promise to review the funding base for the Eastern Area, that this meeting take place no later than January 31, 1980.
