RESOLUTION NO. 80-19


- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an Inter-Tribal Council which represents the Chitimacha Tribe, Coushatta Tribe, Eastern Band of Cherokees, Miccosukee Tribe, Mississippi Band of Choctaws, Passamaquoddy Pleasant Point and Indian Township Tribes, Penobscot Nation, Seminole Tribe, Seneca Nation and St. Regis Mohawk Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of United South and Eastern Tribes has given consideration to the importance of the Evergreen Foundations production of BURY MY HEART AT WOUNDED KNEE, and
- WHEREAS, this production and the educational program developed in conjunction with this production will have a major impact on the publics image of the history of Indian people, now
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of United South and Eastern Tribes supports the Evergreen Foundation and their television production of the mini series BURY MY HEART AT WOUNDED KNEE.
