WHEREAS, Law and Order on the Reservation is of prime importance for the fulfillment of self-development; and


WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians does not have adequate Law enforcement facilities at present; and

WHEREAS, the renovation of the former IHS building as a law enforcement facility has been proven to be feasible; now


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the United South and Eastern Tribes urges the Bureau of Indian Affairs support the Eastern Band of Cherokee's effort to utilize the FY'82 3rd quarter renovation funds for said renovation, and that it be placed as a high priority on the renovation funding list for FY'83.
