A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT A SENATE VERSION OF AN AMERICAN INDIAN HOUSING BILL FOR 1980

WHEREAS, the Interior and Insular Committee of the House of Representatives on May 19, 1982, reported and ordered out of the committee H.R. 5988, the Indian Housing Act of 1982, and

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes on April 29, 1982 testified in favor of H.R. 5988 before Congressman Morris K. Udall, Chairman of the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs, and


WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes have a critical housing shortage and need for both new construction and renovation programs, and


WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes have combined new construction and renovation need for approximately 7,000 units; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Board of Directors of United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. does hereby urge and request the Chairman, Senator Cohen of the Senate Select Committee on Indian Affairs to introduce a Senate version of an American Indian Housing Bill for 1982.
