WHEREAS, American Indian Day has been for many years celebrated on the last Friday in Septembers; and


WHEREAS, in recent years, there has been some confusion as to when American Indian Day would be celebrated; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eastern Tribes will celebrate American Indian Day on the last Friday of September; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Eastern Tribes urge all other American Indians to celebrate American Indian Day the last Friday in September.
