WHEREAS, the close working relationship of the Nashville Program Office and the Eastern Tribes through United South and Eastern Tribes has had an immeasurable impact upon the provision of health care to the Indian people in the east; and


WHEREAS, the Eastern Tribes want the Nashville Program Office to relocate to the Calumet Center in 1985; and


WHEREAS, the growth of the Nashville Program Office has had a positive impact upon the health care provision and that this growth in staff and functions has not been followed by an increase in useful office space for operations, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of the Nashville Program Office utilize the resources of his Office Management budget to increase the useful space of the Nashville Program Office at the Calumet Center to a level necessary for proper provision of services.
