WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an Inter-Tribal Council which represents twelve federally recognized American Indian Tribes in the eastern United States, and

WHEREAS, the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe has requested membership into the United South and Eastern Tribes, and


WHEREAS, federal agencies have recognized the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe through allocation of Indian Health funds and other federal programs, and


WHEREAS, membership of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe and representation on the Board of Directors requires an amendment to the By-Laws of the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the By-Laws be amended to include the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe.
