


UNITED SOUTH AND EASTERN TRIBES

RESOLUTION NO. C-84-136

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an Inter-Tribal Council which represents twelve federally recognized American Indian Tribes in the eastern United States; and,
- WHEREAS, the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe has requested membership into the United South and Eastern Tribes; and,
- WHEREAS, federal agencies have recognized the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe through allocation of Indian Health funds and other federal programs; and,
- WHEREAS, the Executive Committee/Administrative Operations Committee of the Board of Directors of USET recommends to the full Board of Directors the inclusion of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe; and,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Committee and Administrative Operations Committee sanction this resolution for full approval of the Board of Directors at the next Semi Annual Board Meeting (May).
