RESOLUTION NO. C-85-150


- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an inter-Tribal Council whose membership is comprised of sixteen federally recognized American Indian Tribes throughout the eastern United States; and
- WHEREAS, the member Tribes of the United South and Eastern Tribes see the need to meet and discuss issues with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Indian Health Service, Department of Housing and Urban Development, Administration for Native Americans and other agencies that have a major impact upon reservation development; and
- WHEREAS, in many instances Tribal leadership and staff are sometimes torn between conflicting meetings throughout the year; and
- WHEREAS, the resources necessary to support staff and leadership travel is becoming excessive; and
- WHEREAS, the coordination of agency meetings would have a positive impact on the necessity to travel and be away from the reservation; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the elected leadership of the United South and Eastern Tribes do instruct the above agencies to coordinate their meetings through the headquarters office of the United South and Eastern Tribes in Nashville, Tennessee; now

THEREFORE BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED, that the elected leadership of the United South and Eastern Tribes instruct agency heads and various departments within their purvey to coordinate any meetings between their agency and any group of member Tribes through the headquarters office of United South and Eastern Tribes in Nashville, Tennessee.

CERTIFICATION
