Resolution No. C-86-168

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated is an inter-Tribal Council made up of sixteen federally recognized American Indian Tribes; and

WHEREAS, The Chitimacha Tribe, Coushatta Tribe, and Tunica-Biloxi Tribe collectively in the State of Louisiana are desirous of establishing an agency of the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the benefit of those mentioned Tribes in the State of Louisiana; and


WHEREAS, In order to deliver the BIA services more effectively to the Tribes located in Louisiana, an agency office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs is necessary; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the USET Board of Directors supports the efforts of its member Tribes in establishing an office of the Bureau in Louisiana; and


THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the USET Board of Directors does hereby urge the Bureau of Indian Affairs to work with the Tribes in Louisiana in establishing such an agency.
