- WHEREAS United South & Eastern Tribes is an Inter-Tribal Council representing sixteen federally recognized Indian Tribes located in the Eastern part of the United States; and
- WHEREAS The Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana is a member of the Inter-Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS The Chitimacha Tribe's Land Claims Settlement is before the United States Congress (H.R. 2329); and
- WHEREAS The settlement of the land claims is of paramount importance to the Tribe;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors of United South and Eastern Tribes supports passage of the Land Claims Settlement and encourages the 100th Congress to act swiftly towards that end.
