


UNITED SOUTH AND EASTERN TRIBES, INC.


Resolution No. B-88-196

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an inter-tribal Council composed of seventeen federally recognized tribes in the Eastern United States; and
- WHEREAS, The Tlingit Indian Community of Angoon, Alaska, has submitted and has introduced in the Congress of the United States legislation, designated H.R. 2596, to enhance the management of the Admiralty Island National Preserve; and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of this act is the continuing protection and preservation of the Tlingit culture and heritage on Admiralty Island; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the interests of all the American Indians and Alaska Natives throughout the United States to support the preservation of their culture and heritage.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. supports the passage of such legislation on behalf of the Tlingit Indians of Angoon, Alaska.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution be submitted for the record at hearings concerning this matter.
