ESTABLISH A USET COMMITTEE FOR OLDER NATIVE AMERICAN NEEDS

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of 18 federally-recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, USET tribes recognize the valuable contributions made by their elder members and hold these older Native Americans in high regard; and


WHEREAS, USET is deeply concerned with the needs of older Native Americans,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT USET form a committee, comprised of representatives from each member tribe, to collectively study the needs of older Native Americans, exchange information on programs, and serve as an advocate for older Native Americans; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this committee shall meet in conjunction with the USET Board, prepare and deliver reports to the Board, and propose resolutions for the Board's consideration.
