Resolution # B-90-289


- Whereas, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. is an inter-tribal organization comprised of eighteen (18) federally-recognized tribes; and
- Whereas, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of the member tribes collectively; and
- Whereas, it is the goal of tribal leadership and USET, Inc. to promote Native American economic development for its member tribes, acting individually and collectively through USET; and
- Whereas, the USET Board of Directors has previously committed itself to the concept of developing an office building complex as an economic enterprise in cooperation with Calumet Development Corporation (as per USET resolution # B-88-214); and
- Whereas, the USET Board of Directors now wishes to formalize this commitment.

Now therefore be it resolved that the USET Board of Directors does hereby express its support and commitment to the development of an office complex through Calumet Development Corporation, and


Be it further resolved that Calumet Development Corporation is hereby supported by the USET Board in its pursuit of all avenues to achieve this goal.
