Resolution No. B-90-290

EXPEDITION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL
INDIAN GAMING COMMISSION IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE
INDIAN GAMING REGULATORY ACT OF 1988

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of eighteen (18) federally-recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, USET is firmly committed to the goal of economic development for each member tribe and each tribes sovereign right to gauge the gaming activities for the benefit of their people; and
- WHEREAS, the United States Government has created an "Indian Gaming Commission" for the purpose of protecting Indian economic development; and
- WHEREAS, the member tribes of USET support this purpose and the creation of the Commission.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board of Directors strongly endorses the National Indian Gaming Commission and the appointment of the following Commission members:

John Gonzalez

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the USET Board of Directors requests that the federal government move with all speed to officially establish this Commission, seat its members and allow it to perform its intended functions.
