
REQUEST FOR AT LEAST 6,000 NEW HOUSING UNIT APPROPRIATIONS
FROM DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (DHUD)

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of eighteen (18) federally-recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, USET has established a Housing Committee comprising of representatives from their member Tribal Housing Authorities; and
- WHEREAS, it is the objective and goal of this Housing Committee to see that their housing programs provide safe, decent, and sanitary housing for their tribal members and families; and
- WHEREAS, the Federal Budget has appropriated zero units for Indian housing for Fiscal Year 1991; and
- WHEREAS, there is a dire need for an estimated 90,000 (ninety thousand) new units of Indian housing to meet these needs in Indian Communities.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT USET requests a Department of Housing and Urban Development (DHUD) appropriation of at least 6,000 (six thousand) units for Indian housing in order to meet this critical need in Indian Country.
