

UNITED SOUTH AND EASTERN TRIBES, INC.

Resolution No. B-90-298

REQUEST THAT THERE BE SUFFICIENT TIME ALLOTTED FROM THE NOTICE OF FUND AVAILABILITY (NOFA) DATE TO THE SUBMISSION DEADLINE AND THAT THIS PERIOD SHOULD EQUAL NO LESS THAN 90 DAYS

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of eighteen (18) federally-recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and

WHEREAS, USET has established a Housing Committee comprising of representatives from their member Tribal Housing Authorities; and

WHEREAS, there are a number of grants that could benefit the Indian Housing Programs and those participants that we serve; and

WHEREAS, the notification and response deadlines for many grants do not allow for sufficient time for Indian Housing Authorities to participate in these grant proposals.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT there be sufficient time allotted from the Notice of Fund Availability (NOFA) date to the submission deadline and that this period should equal no less than 90 (ninety) days in order to offer the opportunity to participate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT USET support and voice this recommendation to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (DHUD) and their participating agencies.
