SUBMITTAL OF PROPOSAL TO ANA TO ESTABLISH REGIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS NETWORK AND DEVELOP TRIBAL LEADERSHIP TRAINING AND ORIENTATION PACKAGES

the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an WHEREAS. inter-tribal organization comprised of eighteen federally-recognized tribes; and

actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors WHEREAS. officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and

USET is firmly committed to the goal of advancing the managerial WHEREAS, capacities of each member tribe and their ability to govern themselves and provide for the economic development of their respective communities; and

USET recognizes the need for member tribes and tribal leaders to WHEREAS, seek educational training and development programs which better prepare them for their responsibilities; and

USET also recognizes the need for tribes to improve their WHEREAS. methods of communication through regional approaches.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board of Directors authorizes the Executive Director to submit a proposal to Administration for Native Americans (ANA) for the purposes of establishing a regional telecommunications network, and to develop tribal leadership training and orientation packages for the purpose of furthering self-sufficiency, economic development and leadership skills.
