USET SUPPORT AND COORDINATION OF A NORTHEAST ASSISTANCE
AND TRAINING PROGRAM


- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of nineteen (19) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, USET has long recognized the potential benefits which accrue when tribes share their experience and expertise; and
- WHEREAS, the Northeast tribes, as members of USET, have designed a "Northeast Assistance and Training Program" as a model for the enhancement of the exchange of technical assistance, implementation of training workshops, and as a forum for issues specific to the region.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board fully supports the concept of inter-tribal regional cooperation for the purpose of training and technical assistance and tribal programs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the USET Board agrees that the USET organization be considered as an "organizational conduit" for the facilitation of this training and technical assistance approach and assist the Northeast tribes in securing funding for this venture from relevant federal agencies.
