USET SUPPORT OF INDIAN CULTURAL CENTER

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. ("USET") is comprised of nineteen (19) federally recognized Indian Tribes located in the South and Eastern Part of the United States; and

WHEREAS, USET Tribes are distinct cultural entities rich with heritage and tradition; and


WHEREAS, USET Tribes recognize that the creation and development of an Indian Cultural Center will enhance the Tribes' ability to communicate and educate individuals of their culture and tradition; and


WHEREAS, the federal government through the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) has discretionary funds available for cultural and economic development projects;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT USET supports and authorizes the submission of an ANA application for the development of a USET Indian Cultural Center to be located in Nashville, Tennessee.
